



Their Species and Ours

If ever there was a demonstration of the oligarchical principle in action, we saw it on spectacular display yesterday by the British Empire's agents on both sides of the Atlantic.

In Italy, unelected British viceroy Mario Monti pronounced that youth, who are now suffering a 31% unemployment rate, "must get accustomed to having no fixed job in life; let us also say that it is boring to have [a job] throughout your life." President Napolitano's response to the unemployment catastrophe was to announce cynically that the country should just "go towards a different measurement of affluence." And Italy is only one case: in Greece, youth unemployment is now 43%; in Spain, it is 51.4%.

In the United States, Republican front-runner Mitt Romney told CNN that "I am not concerned about the very poor," since there is a "very ample safety net" in the country. That's with 46 million Americans under the poverty line; 56 million on Medicaid; 45 million on food stamps; and all of these programs being savaged by the fascist policies of Republicans and Democrats alike in Washington—led by Barack Obama. In fact, Michelle Obama yesterday had the temerity to tell people that the economy was making "remarkable progress."

"This is *disgusting*," Lyndon LaRouche stated simply.

But far worse than the specific economic atrocities being imposed by the British Empire, is the *philosophical outlook* behind them. The utter disdain for human life; the belief that the world's population must be reduced down to a billion people; the willingness to unleash even thermonuclear war to stop any change that threatens the oligarchy—these are the hallmarks of a species whose extinction, like that of the dinosaurs, is assured. But will they take down the entire *human species* with them?

That is the central organizing issue that has to be posed, in just those terms—as Lyndon LaRouche and the Basement scientific team have done rigorously in the last two LPAC Weekly Reports [[Jan. 25](#) ^[1], [Feb. 1](#) ^[2]]. Nothing less can provide a solution to the crisis.

The [Feb. 1 LPAC Weekly Report](#) ^[2] was a major success, LaRouche commented today, because it framed that necessary scientific discussion in the strategic context that his opening remarks provided, and it therefore had real impact. We're on the verge of a thermonuclear war initiated by the British monarchy; we are faced with a related general

collapse of the world economy; and with Romney et al on the Republican side and an unchallenged Obama on the Democratic side, the U.S. is on course for extinction.

"These are the conditions under which we're talking about any issue, including scientific issues," LaRouche said in his introductory remarks in the Feb. 1 Weekly Report. "The chief subject that will be discussed here today, will be factors in the population of species. Which species are going to survive, and which not. And we have something to present today, which is extremely important from a scientific standpoint, but with the afore-said political implications, strategic implications."

In the context of that leadership provided by LaRouche, note the scientific optimism expressed over the last couple of days by the discussion of space colonization— in Russia, China, and even Europe and the United States. That is *our species* speaking!

As for the British Empire's ongoing drive for war against Russia and China, and this week's efforts to use the fabricated Syria crisis to isolate and attack Russia, Lyndon LaRouche commented today that Russia is stronger than most people give them credit for. They view those other Russians who are carrying out an attempted destabilization of the country, as traitors. They are British agents—like the case of Gorbachev. This is war, LaRouche said, and the Russians know it.

In the United States, he added, people who capitulate to Obama have already lost their membership in the human race. If we survive this crisis, people will hate those people more than anything else. Traitors are hated more than enemies—and that holds both for the U.S. and Russia.
