Enclosed is a copy of the "DeFeo Report", a document prepared for Attorney General Edward Levi in 1975 by a Justice Department team headed by Michael DeFeo, now the head of the Organized Crime Strike Force for the western states. The report documented criminality in the Drug Enforcement Administration and related sections of the Department of Justice. I think the most relevant pages are 15-16, detailing an informant employed by Thomas Puccio. If you have any questions re. the DeFeo Report or any other matters we have been discussing I am available all next week at my office in New York City.

I have also enclosed a series of other documents that we have recently prepared and presented to several Administration officials in Washington. I am sure that Mr. Schiavone will find these documents of interest.

I did succeed in speaking by phone on Friday with Mr. Shortley in Washington and we are working on arrangements to meet face to face re. the investigation that we discussed.

You will be interested to know that one of my associates spoke yesterday with James Polk from NBC television who recently spoke with Leon Silverman. Silverman indicated to him that his report would thoroughly exonerate Mr. Donovan and Schiavone Construction from any wrongdoing. He further indicated that Silverman had taken a polygraph test on Fred Furino and Furino had passed the test while stating that he had no knowledge of Donovan connections to organized crime.
